- Where:** Minahik Wasau Center, Timber Bay, Saskatchewan
The Centre has dormitories/cabins to accommodate the PATH staff and trainee families.
- When:** Sat. afternoon, April 24, 2010 through Sat. morning, June 19, 2010
- Cost:** **Registration Fee: \$100.00 per single or family unit**
This non-refundable fee is due by Jan. 31, 2010 to be invoiced to your mission agency or church upon receipt of on-line registration. Fee will be applied to your administration fee. In the event you mail in your registration form, please attach cheque or money order of \$100.

***Explanation of charges:** Room and Board charges are set by Minahik Wasau Center as we are renting their facilities. This is their rate. Administration charges are set to cover the costs of operating the PATH program including speaker expenses, general operational costs, MK Ministry costs, etc. Fees may be paid through your mission office/church or paid directly to PATH.

**60% of your Room/Board must be postmarked by March 1. The remainder is due upon arrival on April 24.

***PILAT is a specialized line-item expense that will be charged only to PILAT participants. The more who register for this workshop track in Week #7 (June 7-11), the less each PILAT participant will pay. For example, if only one participant enrolls, the cost is \$637. If two enroll, the cost to each is \$329. If three enroll, the cost to each is \$227. For further figures, contact the administrator or visit the website.

Participants are encouraged to make their final decision regarding enrolling for PILAT by the evening of May 4, 2010 following the *Cultural Bridges with Language* workshop earlier that day. PILAT fees will be invoiced separately and payable at the beginning of Week #7.

Trainees are responsible for purchasing:

- Phone card for international calls outside of Canada and the U.S. (*purchase in Canada*)
- "Required Reading" books
(in the event that trainees cannot locate a certain book, contact the PATH administrator ASAP)
- Personal travel expenses
- All personal items (*snacks, etc*)
- Park fee & gas for Waskesiu family outing (*voluntary - may be shared*)
